# Summary and last tips

- Plenty of databases and tools are available for genome annotation
- Some of us were presented here
- Some have :
  - A Galaxy interface  
OR
  - A web interface  
OR
  - An integration in an annotation platform  
OR
  - Some others need to be installed by one of your favorite bioinformatician :)
- Take care of the obsolescence of database releases (look at the date of the last release)
- Avoid to publish annotations without their sources (ID of entries) in supplementary data
- First, read the user docs of tools/databases
- If needed: put issues on Github (or other ticketing system) or send mail to maintainers
- Participate to meet-up or a training sessions
