

## PARADIGM LAYOUTS – things to consider

- Need to represent at the same time:
    - o Word-forms that cannot be generated (lacunae)
    - o Word-forms that can be generated but haven't been observed
    - o Word-forms that can be generated and have been observed
    - o Optional morpheme boundaries
    - o Prompt for possible recordings for inflected forms
    - o Row/column labels
  - Potential strategies
    - o Greyed-out cells
    - o Bolding word-forms
    - o Greying word-forms
